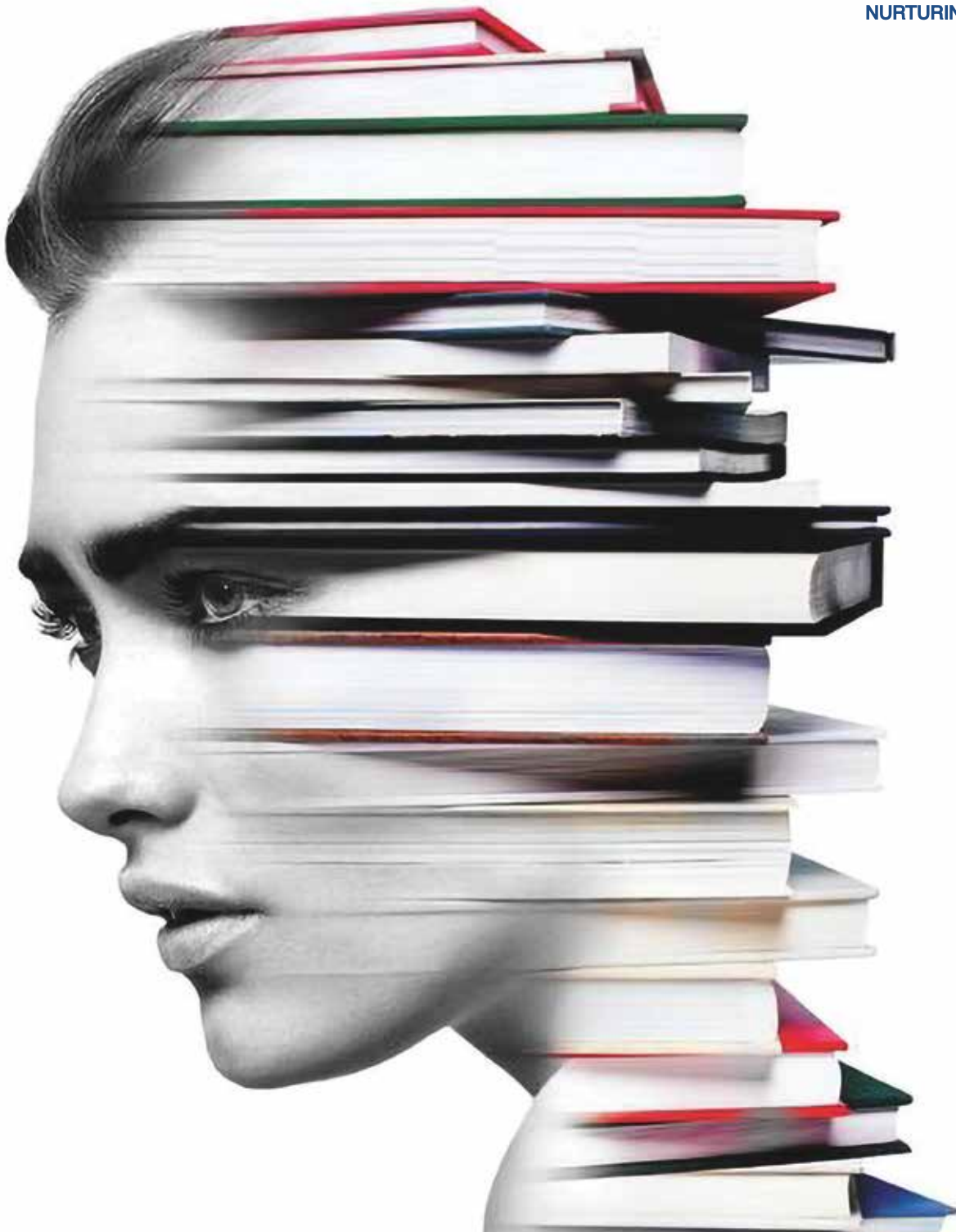

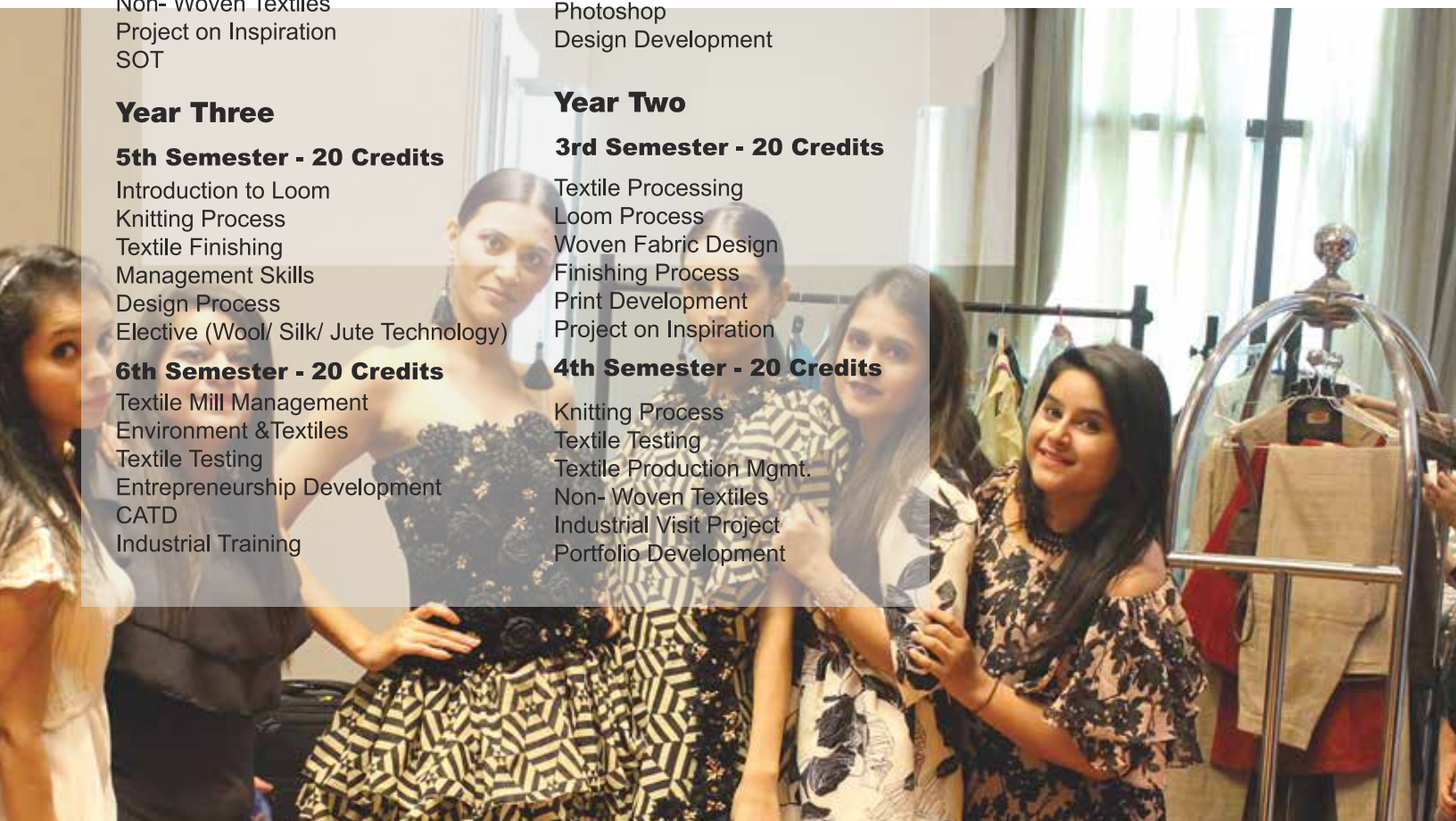

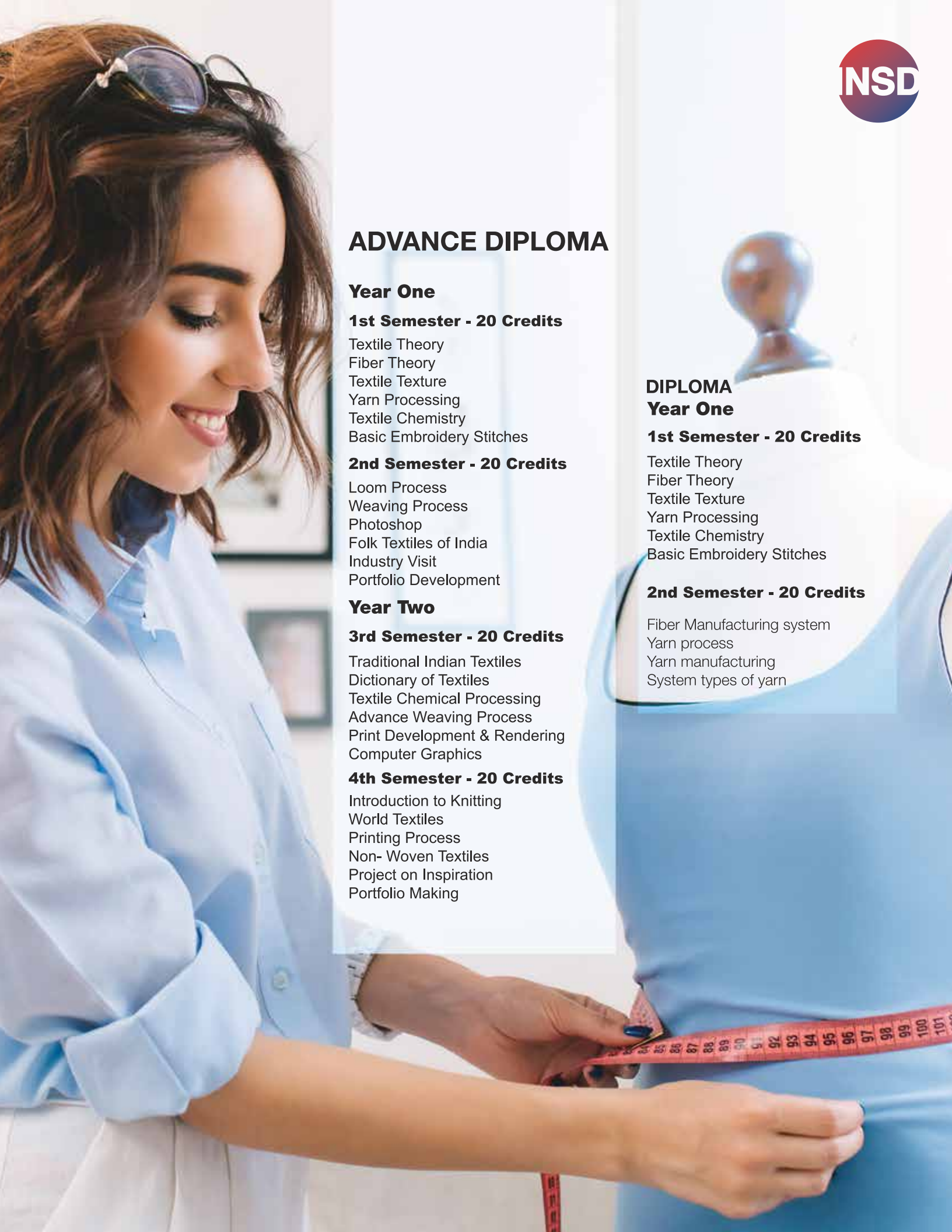

ADMISSION PROCEDURE
